We will tighten our tier 1 small group reading and ensure that all teachers and our reading aides are trained in knowing how to work on specific skills during our tier 2 What I Need (WIN) time for all of our students.

We will focus our professional learning on areas of need to help our students be successful. These professional learning areas may include STEM related topics, student engagement, and the Science of Reading research.
