Subgroup	Percentage	Based on your data, what will you do to increase student learning in these subgroups?
Students identified as economically disadvantaged	70%	We will continue to do frequent progress monitoring for early interventions and work to improve all tiers of instruction.
Students with disabilities	66%	We will do frequent progress monitoring and improve collaboration between classroom teachers and SPED. We hope to see growth in this area improve. After gathering data, intervention groups will be based on specific skills and needs and have a specific scope and sequence.
Students identified as English learners	45%	We will continue to monitor and focus on reading interventions. We will continue to have students do Imagine Learning daily.
Students in major racial and ethnic groups	80%	We will continue monitoring and work to improve all tiers of instruction.

**What tier 1 changes might help those subgroups and your school's level of performance?**

Grade level teams need to continue to meet together and analyze formative assessments and benchmarks. Teams will also determine what concepts need to be retaught to the entire class, based on data. Teachers will continue to coordinate with special education teachers for intervention time. Aides will be leading WIN groups and helping teachers in their progress monitoring. New WIN groups will be organized every two weeks. Teachers will continue to train on 98% materials for interventions.

**What additional interventions might help those subgroups?**

Continue to help students feel accountable for their progress. Have them chart their progress. Increase better communication between teachers about instructional strategies that they have found successful, focused scaffolding of support, and increased student engagement of these subgroups during Tier 1 instruction.
